

Hi everyone - Members, Staff and Board

The three yearly National Convention of YWCA Australia will be held in Canberra over the weekend of November 27-28-29 this year. Members of the YWCA Australia are the Local Associations, such as YWCA of Adelaide. Each local association has voting rights at the convention based on membership, dollar turnover and percentage of quota paid each year.

At the Board meeting last night, the Board resolved to support attendance of four people at the convention: one Board member, one member of staff, one member (who is not staff) and the Chief Executive.

The YWCA will pay air travel, airport transfers and provide an allowance which will cover accommodation and the convention dinner.

The Board has requested that anyone interested in being a YWCA of Adelaide delegate provide a 200 word expression of interest in attending the convention.

Given the need to plan and book the travel and accommodation, the Board has asked that EOIs be submitted to the Chief Executive by Tuesday November 3 and the Board will make a decision by Friday November 6.

Remember that you need to be free to travel to Canberra by Friday November 27, departing on November 29 or 30.
